Social Skills for Teens 2012

The Social Skills for Teens Training focuses on parent-assisted social skills training with particular attention given to development of best friend relationships.

These classes are tailored for teens ages 13 through 17 with FASD. During the sessions the teens will learn communication skills, including electronic communication, choosing friends, sportsmanship, handling bullying, rejection, rumors, and gossip. They will practice the skills through behavior rehearsal and coaching to reduce negative behaviors and promote positive social skills. Simultaneously, parents are taught about core deficits of FASD that keep teens from making friends. They are also given the companion information to their teen's sessions so they can help their teen practice between sessions.

Social Skills for Teens Training is for teens ages 13 – 17
(both teen and parent/guardian need to attend each session).
