WHAT: *Women's Initiative* of United Way, along with United Way of Greater Toledo and Women of Toledo are proud to endorse Toledo City Council's proposed "Pay Equity Act."

This ordinance would create legal repercussions for employers within the City of Toledo to ask for, or require, previous salary history when candidates are applying for a job. Particularly, this protects women and minority women, who historically are paid 80 cents to every dollar their male counterparts earn. The concern is that already underpaid positions, reported on applications, perpetuates unfair compensation.
