Acorn Alley & Rocket Overtime: Provides Benton-Carroll-Salem School children with safe, educational environments beyond school hours

Champions for Children: Provides Port Clinton City School children with safe, educational environments beyond school hours

Community Support Services: Helps individuals and families through comprehensive case management

Countdown to Kindergarten: Prepares Port Clinton City School children to enter kindergarten

Free Tax Prep: Offers free Federal and State tax preparation for residents of Ottawa County

Joyful Connections: Provides supervised visitation for children and their families to stay connected

Launch Pad: Prepares Benton-Carroll-Salem School children to enter kindergarten through activities and parent workshops

Out-of-School STARS: Provides Genoa area school children with out-of-school programming

Ruthann's House: Provides transitional housing for women

TNT Mentoring: Matches adults with youth to support educational success and post-graduation plans
