Meal Reservations Continue for Students in Need

WHO: United Way 2-1-1, United Way of Greater Toledo

Toledo Public Schools Connecting Kids to Meals

WHAT: Due to Governor DeWine's recent announcement on the

extension of school closures, United Way 2-1-1 will

continue to take meal reservations for students until May 1,

2020.

Currently, United Way 2-1-1 is reserving meal pickups for eight Toledo Public Schools and 18 Connecting Kids to

Meals sites.

By reaching out to United Way 2-1-1, individuals can reserve meals for children, 18 years or younger, at either a Toledo Public School or Connecting Kids to Meals site

(whichever is nearest to their home).

Various meal-service-logistics at other schools in Lucas, Wood and Ottawa County are listed in 2-1-1 for individuals to receive. Adults seeking food resources can also locate food sites and pantries near them through 2-1-1.

Please note that some Toledo Public School serving hours and dates will alter due to spring break, starting the week of 4/13/20.
