United Way 2-1-1 to Host Community Training

- WHO: United Way 2-1-1 Great Lakes Community Action Partnership (GLCAP) Local Initiatives Support Corporation of Toledo (LISC Toledo) 100+ registrants
- **WHAT:** United Way 2-1-1 and its community partners at LISC and GLCAP will host an online 2-1-1 Community Training, focusing on Financial Opportunity Centers.

The online gathering will begin with a brief overview of 2-1-1, i.e., how the program works and how community members can get connected to the health and human services they deserve.

The conversation will then transition to rural and urban Financial Opportunity Centers in the Greater Toledo area, led by GLCAP and LISC.

Financial Opportunity Centers provide one-on-one financial coaching and education, as well as employment assistance, for low to moderate-income individuals/families. Coaches help participants build credit, increase their net income and harness available, qualifying financial supports.
